# 7th International Abilympics <br> Vocational Skills Contest 

## L1. Embroidery

## 1. Task

Embroider a pattern pre-traced on a linen cloth ( $27 \times 36 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 2. Allocated time

Maximum 6 hours

## 3. Instructions

(a) Contestants are not allowed to lend or borrow tools, etc., during the contest.
(b) Contestants shall notify the judge when they finish the task.

## 4. Specifications

(a) Contestants can use any stitch technique of expressing the assigned design pattern at their discretion.
(b) Contents can use colors of their own choice and determine the number of embroidery threads at their discretion.
5. Equipment and materials to be prepared on site
(a) Work table (Approx. $1200 \times 600 \times 700(\mathrm{~mm})$ : One per contestant
(b) Chair: One per contestant
(c) Mat (for a contestant who prefers to sit on the floor): one for each relevant contestant
(d) Iron: One shared by two contestants
(e) Ironing board: One shared by two contestants
(f) Desk lamp: One per contestant
(f) Cloth (linen $27 \mathrm{~cm} \mathrm{x} \mathrm{36cm}$ ): One per contestant
(g) Embroidery threads (No. 25 in 20 colors)

## 6. Items to be brought by each contestant

(a) Embroidery needles (No.3, No. 4, No. 5 and No. 6)
(b) Embroidery scissors
(d) Embroidery frame ( 15 cm )
(Note) Contestants who wish to bring their own equipment, tools, etc., are requested to prepare a list of such tools and present it to the organizer for approval in advance. The organizer reserves the right not to allow the use of any tools that are considered to give the contestant an unfair advantage.

## 7. Evaluation criteria

The skills of each contestant will be assessed based on the final work produced.

| Overall appearance (Artistic quality, aesthetic <br> appeal) | 30 |
| Reverse finish (Cleanness of thread handling) | 10 |
| Embroidery skill level (Technique and expression) | 30 |
| Color sense (Aesthetical and balanced choice of <br> colors) | 30 |
| Total | 100 |
