V9. Dental Techniques

1. Task

Task1:

Make an arrangement of artificial teeth and gingivoplasty for a complete denture prosthesis using the upper and lower edentulous jaw model (cast).

Task 2:

Develop a wax pattern for two dental crowns and a three-tooth bridge.

2. Allocated time:

Maximum 5 hours

3. Instructions

- (1) Contestants are not allowed to lend or borrow materials, tools, etc., during the contest.
- (2) A contestant who has trouble with or a malfunction in equipment used shall notify the judge immediately.
- (3) Contestants shall notify the judge when they have finished the task.

4. Materials to be provided

Task 1

- (1) A set of biteplates for the upper and lower teeth installed in the articulator
- (2) Artificial upper and lower front teeth
- (3) Artificial upper and lower molars
- (4) Paraffin wax: 2 sheets
- (5) Articulating paper: 2 sheets each of red and blue
- (6) Dental towel: 2 towels

Task 2

- (1) Model for contest, installed in the articulator
- (2) Inlay wax: 4 sticks
- (3) Wax separating agent: 1 bottle
- (4) Dental towel: 2 sheets
- (5) Rubber dam: 1
- (6) Articulating Paper: 2 each of red and blue

5. Equipment and tools to be prepared on site
