V11. Dress Making - Basic Course

1. Task

Fabricate an apron in the design shown below using the pre-cut material, which will be provided.

2. Allocated time

4 hours

3. Instructions


- (a) Adjustment of the sewing machine should be done by each contestant.
- (b) The materials will be replaced only when there are flaws.
- (c) Contestants are not allowed to lend or borrow tools during the contest.

4. Specifications

- (a) Shoulder strap: Completed width is 2cm. Use the sewing machine to make an edge-stitched seam.
- (b) Waist strap: Completed width is 4 cm. Use the sewing machine to make an edge-stitched seam.

(c) Pocket

- Top edge: Double-fold the cloth with margins of 1 cm and 2 cm, and seam them.




Fig. 3 How to sew the pocket

- Sewing of pocket: Refer to Fig. 3 (How to Sew the Pocket). Double-stitch it using an edge-stitched seam and the width the presser foot, 0.6 cm.
- (d) Inner facing: Double-fold the bottom of the facing with margins of 0.5 cm and 1 cm, and seam them.
- (e) Sewing of shoulder strap: It must be interposed in the facing and bodice (the location to be marked on the fabric).
- (e) Armhole curve: Fold a margin of 1 cm; the stitch width at the armholes up to the chest is 0.6 cm (the width of the presser foot).
- (g) Side and hem: Double-fold the edge with margins of 1 cm and 1.5 cm, and seam them. The order of stitching shall be: stitch the hem, and then seam the side after interposing the waist strap in it.



