## *Vocational Skills Contest*

### **V23. Poster Design**

#### **1. Task**

Design a poster to convey either of the following messages:

- a. “Recovery of Gaia”: Walk Rally on Mt. Fuji

Outline:

A poster inviting people to join in a Walk Rally, which will initiate people to consider what they could and must do for the environment by actually feeling the current problems while walking together on the outskirts of the dynamic Mt. Fuji.

- b. “Love & Peace”: Symposium on Mt. Fuji

Outline:

A poster inviting people to participate in a symposium held under the grandeur of Mt. Fuji. Here, various opinion leaders, who are actually practicing ideas of realizing love and peace once again, get together in order to determine a resolution from their own perspectives.

#### **2. Allocated time**

Six hours

#### **3. How to present the completed work**

Contestants shall store their completed work (or uncompleted work if not finished) in the USB memory and turn it in. Note that the USB memory containing the work will be collected by the contest officials immediately after the allocated time has ended.

#### **4. Work instructions**

Required elements that contestants must incorporate in the poster, such as venue of the event, head copy, event period, as well as various photos that they may use at their discretion, will have been installed in the PC that each contestant will use on the day of the contest. Using these elements, each contestant shall design an eye-catching poster (297mm x 420mm) conveying the message effectively.

## 5. Special Instructions

- a. Reference books, memos, floppy disks, CD-Rs, etc. containing data or program files should not be brought into the site.
- b. The seating position at the site will be determined in advance by the organizer.
- c. Any contestant who has troubles with the equipment used shall follow the instructions of the judge.
- d. Contestants shall notify the judge when they finish the task.

<Note>

Contestants who need special assistive technology/device (hardware and software) shall notify the secretariat in advance. In principle, such contestants should bring it into the contest site during the orientation session and install/attach it in the presence of judges.

No special consideration will be given if there is any trouble with the installed/attached technology/device
