# Vocational Skills Contest

## V25. Tailoring

#### 1. Task

Complete the tailoring of a two-button single suit jacket half-finished with completed sleeves and undercollar, which is provided to each contestant in advance, according to the instructions given below.

#### 2. Allocated Time

Maximum 6 hours (starting with overlaying the upper collar)

#### 3. Instructions




Fig. 2 Completed upper collar

- (a) The upper collar must be made as shown in Fig. 2.




Fig. 3 Attachment of right and left shoulders

- (b) The right and left sleeves must be attached as shown in Fig. 3.
- (c) Buttonhole must be completed and buttons should be attached.
- (d) Other parts may be done at the contestant's discretion.
- (e) Contestants shall notify the judge when they finish the task.

#### 4. Materials to be provided on site

- (a) Half-finished product with the undercollar already made
- (b) Buttons (two front buttons)
- (c) Threads (basting thread, buttonhole twist, plain seam thread, machine-sewing thread, button sewing thread)
- (d) Sewing needles
- (e) Sewing-machine needle (#14 103)
- (f) Sleeve wadding

### 5. Items to be brought by each contestant

(Note) Contestants who wish to bring their own tools other than specified above are requested to prepare a list of such tools and present it to the organizer for approval in advance. The organizer reserves the right not to allow the use of any tools that are considered to give the contestant an unfair advantage.

Attachment of sleeves	40
Buttonhole sewing	5
Overall needlework	5
Finish	10
Overall appearance	10

(Note) Contestants who cannot complete the task or damage their work (burn, cutting damage, inside out error) are to leave the contest.

Fig. 1 Overlaying of upper collar
