### **L3. Painting**

#### **1. Task**

Theme: “Living with Animals”

#### **2. Allocated time**

Maximum 6 hours

#### **3. Instructions**

- Contestants are not allowed to bring their own paints and/or drawing paper.
- Contestants will freely depict the theme using the provided watercolor paints and paintbrushes.
- Two sheets of drawing paper will be provided to each contestant and either one of them must be presented as the final work.
- Contestants are not allowed to lend or borrow materials, tools, etc., during the contest.
- Contestants shall notify the judge when they have completed the task.

#### **4. Equipment and tools to be prepared on site**

Table and chair	One each per contestant
Mat (Used when the table is not required)	One sheet per contestant
Drawing board (with clips)	One board per contestant
Drawing paper (Kent paper)	540mm x 380mm, 2 sheets per contestant
Water colors (A) (transparent color)	Holbein Artists' Water Color, 24-color set
Water colors (B) (opaque color)	Holbein Artists' Water Gouache, 24-color set
Watercolor pencils	12 colors
Watercolor crayons	15 colors
Paintbrush for watercolor paints (round)	Nos. 2, 8, 14
Paintbrush for watercolor paints (flat)	Nos. 2, 8, 14
Pallet	Acrylic design palette
Brush washer	Acrylic bowl for water
Writing utensils	Pencil, eraser

(Note) Contestants who will bring their own tools are requested to present a list of such tools to the organizer for approval in advance. The organizer reserves the right not to allow the use of any tools that are considered to give the contestant an unfair advantage.
